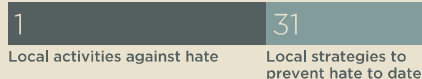

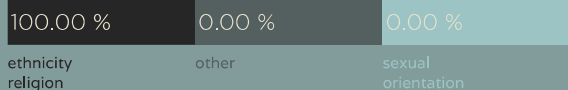

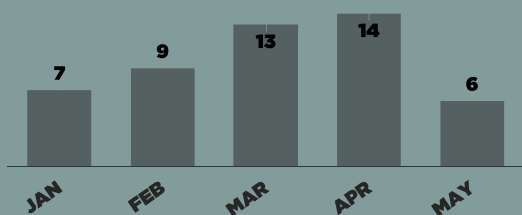

In May, the Mission supported Cultural Diversity Day activities under the Kakanj and Novi Travnik Community Cohesion Action Plans (CCAPs). In Kakanj, over 400 citizens joined discussions and cultural activities with local authorities, civil society organizations, youth and members of the Roma community. In Novi Travnik, students from five primary schools used art to promote inclusion, dialogue and respect, transforming CCAP measures into action.
