In October, the OSCE Mission to Bosnia and Herzegovina supported the administration Gradiška City in implementing a survey to assess citizens' perceptions of social cohesion. The participatory research process engaged more than 200 respondents to generate baseline data that will inform upcoming city activities and serve as the foundation for developing Gradiška's first Community Cohesion Action Plan.
